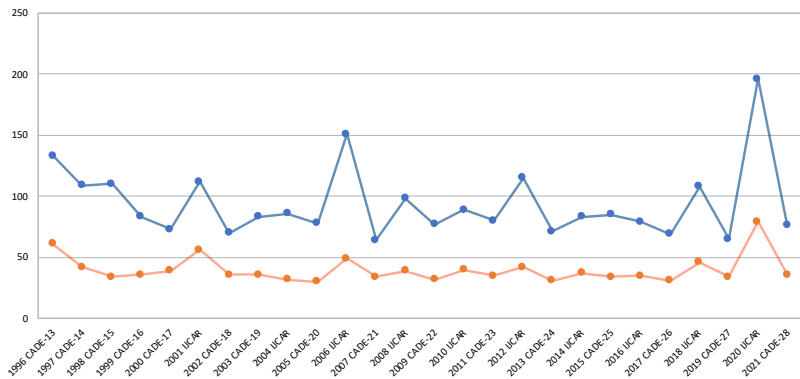
# Submissions and Reviews

# Submitted/Accepted Papers since 1996

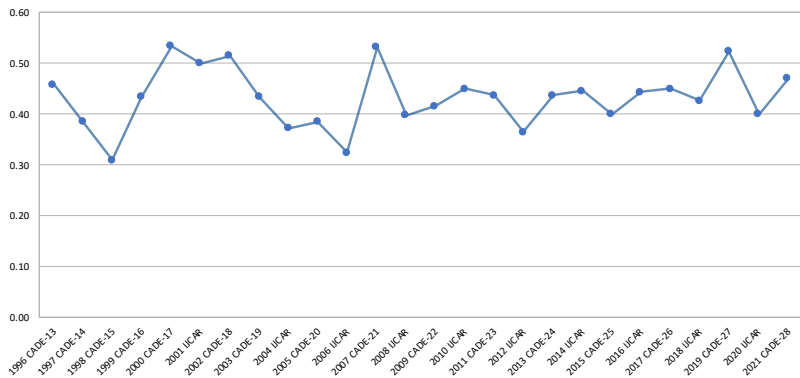




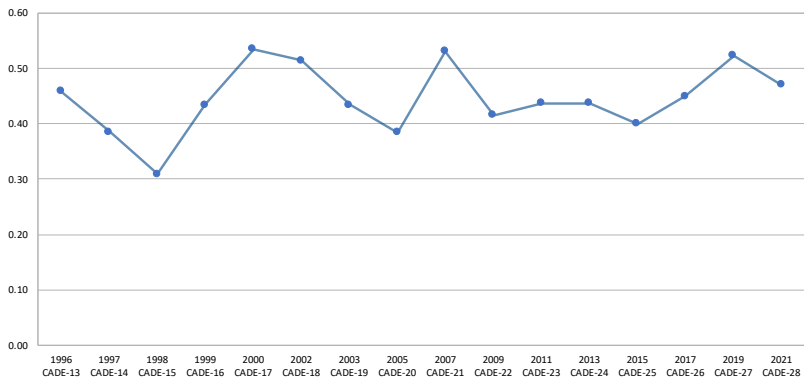
# Submitted/Accepted Papers since 1996 (CADE only)
